19 MR. KUTNER: Would you mind asking if they don't
20 mind sticking around.

21 THE COURT: The attorneys may want to speak to
22 you. You don't have to, but it is important for them to get
23 your prospective. It helps them in their career and how to
24 approach jurors in the future.

25 Attorneys, if you want to speak to the jurors,

1 speak to them in the hallway.

2 You are now excused.

3 (Whereupon, the jury exits the courtroom)

4 THE COURT: All right, all motions. The attorneys
5 have 60 days from today to make post trial motions.

6 MR. KUTNER: Just to protect the record, I want to
7 make a motion to set aside the verdict as contrary to the
8 law, the facts and as against the weight of the evidence.

9 THE COURT: Denied.

10 MR. KUTNER: Renew all motions that were made at
11 the closing of plaintiff's proof?

12 THE COURT: Whatever I ruled, denied.

13 MR. KUTNER: We were going to ask for 60 days.

14 MR. WINIKOW: I join in the same motions that
15 Mr. Kutner made.

16 THE COURT: Do you want to make them in 60 days?

17 MS. OWENS: Everything is preserved? Execution of
18 the judgment is stayed?

19 THE COURT: 60 days until I make a decision.

20 MR. WINIKOW: Your Honor, just so we are clear,
21 entry of judgment will be stayed until the motion is
22 decided?

23 THE COURT: That's what the CPLR says.

24 MR. WINIKOW: I would like to request a collateral
25 source hearing.

1 THE COURT: Try to arrange that and if you have a
2 problem, contact me and I will schedule a hearing.

3 MR. KUTNER: I was making that motion verbally and
4 my understanding is that I have 60 days to submit papers in
5 support of my oral application?

6 MR. KALMAN: All post trial motions on papers in
7 60 days?

8 THE COURT: Thank you all. You did a wonderful
9 job.

10 MR. KUTNER: Your Honor, I wanted to address that
11 there are contractual indemnification claims by DASNY and
12 possibly Bovis pursuant to the items of the contract that
13 were written between DASNY and Martin and DASNY and Cannon.
14 I just want to preserve my right to make my application to
15 the Court with the other motions with respect to the Court's
16 determination as to the applicability of the indemnification
17 provisions and the recovery of defense costs and attorneys'
18 fees as against those entities.

19 THE COURT: All motions within 60 days. Hopefully,
20 you can settle that issue amongst yourselves.

21 (Whereupon, the case is adjourned for post trial
22 motions)
